

RFQ 19H08021Q0015 – Attorney services for the acquisition in freehold of real property
Questions and Answers

Q.1. Can we receive the RFQ in Spanish language?

A.1. No. It is issued in English.

Q.2 Is there a minimum amount of attorneys needed for the project?

A.2 No.

Q.3 Would you prefer a Retainer for the services mentioned?

A.3 No.

Q.4 Has there been any type of communication with the owner of the house?

A.3. Not at this time. Pre-selection of residences has not begun.

Q.5 If you have any specific information, it would be highly appreciated.

A.5. Submit your quotation according to the instructions provided in Section I of the RFQ. As well as the representations requested in Section K.

Q.6 In regards to 2.15: Our firm has the ability to handle translations. Will translations have to be official (authorized by the Official Translator of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs)?

A.6 They have to be a certified translator.

Q.7 Will expenses (such as applicable notary tax stamps, payment to any third specialist, etc.) be provided beforehand by the Embassy of the United States (the “Embassy”) or will these have to be part of our proposal or prepaid by the Contractor and subject to reimburse?

A.7 Some additional expenses shall be reimbursed provided that the cost is approved in advance by the USG.
