ADULT PASSPORT RENEWAL

A renewal application applies only when you are renewing your previous, 10-year validity U.S. passport issued less than 15 years ago.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR AN ADULT PASSPORT RENEWAL?

Passport Application – Form DS-82 <https://eforms.state.gov/forms/ds82.pdf>

Please read and follow the instructions when filling out the form. If you cannot print the form, it is available at the Embassy.

DOCUMENTATION NEEDED

1. Previous U.S. passport
2. One (1) recent photograph, in color, size 2" x 2", with a white background and full front view. Photos that do not meet these requirements will not be accepted.
3. **Fees: non-refundable** 110.00 U.S. Dollars
 - **At the Embassy in Tegucigalpa:** Fees may be paid in U.S. dollars or the equivalent in Lempiras. International credit cards are accepted.
 - **At the Consular Agency in San Pedro Sula:** Fees may only be paid in Lempiras. Exact change is required. International credit cards are accepted.
 - You must pay all fees directly at the Embassy or the Consular Agency. Do not make payments at a bank or any other establishment. Personal checks are not accepted.
4. Turnaround Time:
 - When applying in Tegucigalpa – Approximately 13 working days
 - When applying in San Pedro Sula – Approximately 5 weeks
5. Where to Apply?
 - **Tegucigalpa – Drop Off:** If you are submitting your renewal application at the U.S. Embassy in Tegucigalpa, you may personally drop it off any Monday through Friday, between 10:00 and 11:30 a.m. No interview is required.
 - **San Pedro Sula –Make an Appointment:** If you are submitting your renewal application at the Consular Agency in San Pedro Sula, you should make an appointment online at:
