HOW DO I APPLY FOR AN ADULT PASSPORT RENEWAL

Passport Application – Form DS-82 <https://eforms.state.gov/forms/ds82.pdf>

Please read and follow the instructions when filling out the form.

DOCUMENTATION NEEDED

1. Form DS-82
2. Previous U.S. passport
3. One (1) recent photograph, in color, size 2" x 2", with a white background and full front view. Photos that do not meet these requirements will not be accepted.
4. **Fees: non-refundable** 110.00 U.S. Dollars
 - **At the Embassy in Tegucigalpa:** Fees may be paid in U.S. dollars or the equivalent in Lempiras. International credit cards are accepted.
 - You must pay all fees directly at the Embassy. Do not make payments at a bank or other establishment. Personal checks are not accepted.
5. Turnaround Time:
 - When applying in Tegucigalpa – Approximately 13 business days.
6. Where to Apply?
 - **Tegucigalpa – Make an Appointment:** If you are submitting your renewal application, you should make an appointment for the U.S. Embassy in Tegucigalpa at: <https://hn.usembassy.gov/u-s-citizen-services/passports/make-an-appointment/>
 - **San Pedro Sula –The Consular Agency in San Pedro Sula is currently closed.**
