1.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The Contractor shall provide the requested uninstal services at the point of installation, also furnish and install products in accordance with the conditions, requirements, and specifications enclosed in this solicitation, including a twelve-month maintenance services for the cold room. The price listed below shall include all labor, transportation, installation, materials, equipment, machinery, overhead, and profit. The contract type will be a Firm Fixed-Price under which shall be placed one Purchase Order. In consideration of satisfactory performance of all scheduled services and successful installation of equipment and machinery required under this contract, the Contractor shall be paid a firm fixed-price for all services and goods.

2.0 PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The period of performance for the uninstal services, transportation and installation of all goods is up to ninety (90) calendar days once the Contract is awarded. Dates will be determined by the Contracting Officer Representative (COR) according to the refurbishment work plan of the Forensic Medicine Directorate Morgue in La Ceiba, Honduras.

Maintenance Services must initiate three (03) months after the installation has been performed and the equipment and machinery is set in place working in optimal conditions.

3.0 PRICES

In consideration of satisfactory performance of all scheduled services required under this Contract, the Contractor shall be paid a Firm Fixed Price in **U. S. Dollars**. The Contractor must confirm that is able to charge a tax exempted price since the Government of Honduras has granted the resolution to the U. S. Embassy in Tegucigalpa to acquire goods and services exempted from the value added tax.

4.0 VALUE ADDED TAX

VALUE ADDED TAX. Value Added Tax (VAT) is not applicable to this contract and shall not be included in the CLIN rates or Invoices because the U.S. Embassy has a tax exemption certificate from the host government.

10. Attach the cold room plan view
11. Provide with offer a written statement of the work that will be done during the maintenance services
12. Confirm that Contractor will train and instruct personnel at the Forensic Medicine Directorate Morgue in La Ceiba, Honduras on use, care and handling of equipment
13. Confirm that manuals of equipment, in Spanish will be provided to personnel at the Forensic Medicine Directorate Morgue in La Ceiba, Honduras
14. Offer's validity for at least ninety (90) days
15. The Contractor agrees that the US Government shall not be responsible for personal injuries or for damages to:
