HOW DO I APPLY FOR A REPLACEMENT OF DAMAGED OR MUTILATED U.S. PASSPORT?

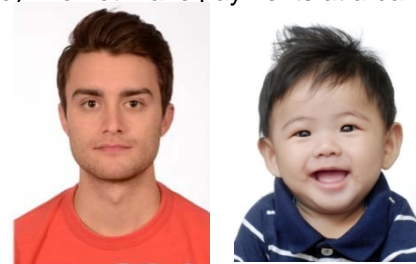

DS-82 – If all the biographical data and photo are NOT damaged.

DS-11– If the passport was mutilated or if the biographical data and/or photo ARE damaged

DOCUMENTATION NEEDED

1. Signed Statement: The statement must satisfactorily explain the circumstances regarding the damage of the passport book.
2. Proof of U.S. Citizenship: Original or certified copy of Birth Certificate, original Consular Report of Birth Abroad, original Naturalization or Citizenship Certificate. If you are over 16 years old and were issued a U.S. passport during your childhood, you may submit it as proof of U.S. citizenship. If you lost your original Birth Certificate, contact your vital records office. If you lost your CRBA, follow these instructions on travel.state.gov. The Embassy cannot replace these documents.
3. Photo Identification: Damaged or Mutilated U.S. passport, Driver's license, or other photo identification card.
4. One (1) recent photograph, in color, size 2" x 2", with a white background and full front view. Photos that do not meet these requirements will not be accepted.
5. **Fees: non-refundable**
 - **Adult Applicants** 145.00 U.S. Dollars
 - **Minor Applicants** 115.00 U.S. Dollars
 - **At the Embassy in Tegucigalpa:** Fees may be paid in U.S. dollars or the equivalent in Lempiras. International credit cards are accepted.
 - **At the Consular Agency in San Pedro Sula:** Fees may only be paid in Lempiras. Exact change is required. International credit cards are accepted.
 - You must pay all fees directly at the Embassy or the Consular Agency. Do not make payments at a bank or any other establishment. Personal checks are not accepted.
6. Turnaround Time:
 - When applying in Tegucigalpa – Approximately 13 working days.
 - When applying in San Pedro Sula – Approximately 5 weeks
